By now you would have read the M.R.A. Victoria/M.R.A. Australia policy statement sent to all M.R.A. State Branches and had some reaction to its content. M.R.A. Victoria has not received any written or verbal response to the policy statement, and I am writing to see if you have had any comments, or wish to make any.

On behalf of M.R.A. Victoria, I am taking the initiative to resolve the M.R.A. rift between states, and I accordingly drafted that document to clearly state our position and ask that despite differences, we work together.

As agreed, memberships and money from other states are now being returned. I have initially sent the original membership forms so that each state can service its members.

The National Newsletter is going ahead smoothly, although delays due to the A.M.C.N. lobbying have meant an increased time workload on our part. I hope that the next set of deadlines can be adhered to.

With regards to the A.M.C., I ask that that matter not be dragged into M.R.A. Australia. I have some fundamental conflicts re the A.M.C. and will not promote M.R.A. Victoria being a part of the A.M.C. until I can be satisfied that it's worth putting the time, finance and effort into such a Council. I trust that you will understand and accept my position re the A.M.C.


