re: Police Traffic Accident Records - Fairway System

We refer to our previous discussions with you in regard to the Application for Legal Assistance.

Please now find enclosed two application forms. You will note that one is on your own behalf and the second is for the Association. Kindly sign them both in the capacity of yourself and on behalf of the Association as the now President of the Association.

Andrew Luck has supplied me with details in regard to the profit and loss statement for the Association which I have included in the Application. Could you please forward the same statement in regard to your own financial position and, as you will note from the Application, you are required to give detailed accounts of your assets and liability structure.

With respect to the payment of the costs incurred to the Road Traffic Authority, they have instructed that they will consider an instalment program, provided we provide evidence of the inability of the Association to pay the sum immediately. In addition, they have requested an indication as to the manner in which the moneys will be paid over a period of twelve months.

Noting that the amount be paid as \$5,750.00 it would therefore seem appropriate that the Association undertakes to pay back those moneys on a monthly basis at the rate of \$479.17 per month. This would seem a reasonable commitment.

Should you agree with our suggestion, then please confirm the same in writing as always requested.
