In the early eighties, local M.R.A. groups became independent of the founding branch, M.R.A.A. Since then many changes have occurred.

M.R.A.A. has become a very different organisation from the other, like-named, groups.

M.R.A.A. has kept up its national role in representation of the Australian Motorcycle Community and has now been invited to represent Australia internationally. M.R.A.A. Vice President, Chris Lamblin, has recently returned from the International Coalition of Motorcyclists annual convention in the United States of America. It was the first time an Australian lobby group has been invited.

M.R.A.A.'s new logo will avoid confusion with other organisations. The new logo is copyright and may NOT be used in any way by groups other than M.R.A.A. Inc. M.R.A.A. maintains the rights to its current logo and will use it from time to time but the new logo is exclusive to M.R.A.A.
